Scope and Sequence:

3 rd	Showing cause and effect direct and indirect speech. Indirect speech: Tense changes. Indirect Instructions, commands, etc	January 6 th to February 28th
4 th	Indirect Questions. Embedded questions. Using direct and indirect speech	March 3rd to May 16 th

Method of Evaluation.
